

## Aesthetic look and pleasing feel: TA03 - the next-generation keypad

Showcasing the TA03, Lehmann, specialist in furniture locks and locking systems, is presenting the next-generation keypad at Interzum Guangzhou. Specially designed for the M410 and M610 series of locks, the TA03 can be used in a wide variety of applications, no least because of the many different design options.

The new keypad from the German furniture lock specialist Lehmann features easy operation, a timeless aesthetic, and a pleasing feel. The striking design of the keypad is brought out by the two colour options of black and nickel which can be combined to make four versions. The high-quality silicon keys have a comfortable feel and are easy to operate.

The keypad design also allows it to double up as a furniture handle. It also comes with the option of attaching numbers at four different positions on the keypad without the need for any tools. Labelling fields which can be customised with domings are a new addition to the range. These can also be fitted without tools. The space can be used for any image, even a personal picture of the user.

Three- to ten-digit keypad codes can be individually selected and the operating mode can be set to use a fixed or any available code. In terms of security, Lehmann has provided for a wide range of eventualities. Highly visible LEDs in three different colours serve as a visual function indicator. Lehmann has also integrated a blocking time to prevent unauthorised attempts at opening a lock.

Security is also provided by the energy management system which now comes with significant improvements over the previous model. The TA03 has a two-stage battery warning function for low-battery status. However, if the battery is not replaced in good time and goes completely flat, the lock remains engaged. A standard monobloc battery can then be used as an emergency power supply, and there is also an emergency unlocking code.

But these are not the only features that make the TA03 ideal for a wide variety of applications. The keypad is also resistant to standard detergents and disinfectants. It is also impervious to the ingress of dust and water spray which significantly extends the range of potential applications. In addition to hospitals, wet areas such as swimming pools and saunas are also an obvious area of use.

With the TA03, Lehmann has developed an extremely high-quality keypad. In combination with M410 and M610 locks, it is ideally suited for many different applications.
