The lockers can be numbered efficiently and reliably on site. The predefined frame means the numbering can be cost-effectively fitted on site. Domatics or metal or paper tags can also be individually fitted. As there are only a few components, this saves both time and money during production and on site – whatever the installation. In addition to this, it is possible to customise a project at almost no extra cost. Short lead times and the option of refreshing the numbering when the locker changes hands are further benefits.

LEHMANN is also adding the new SOLO tag carrier to the product range with immediate effect. This allows a specific locker to be conveniently labelled independent of the lock. The key benefit here is that the position can be determined individually. This gives the relevant locker a clear and structured design using appropriate numbering as with the current LEHNUM tag carrier.
